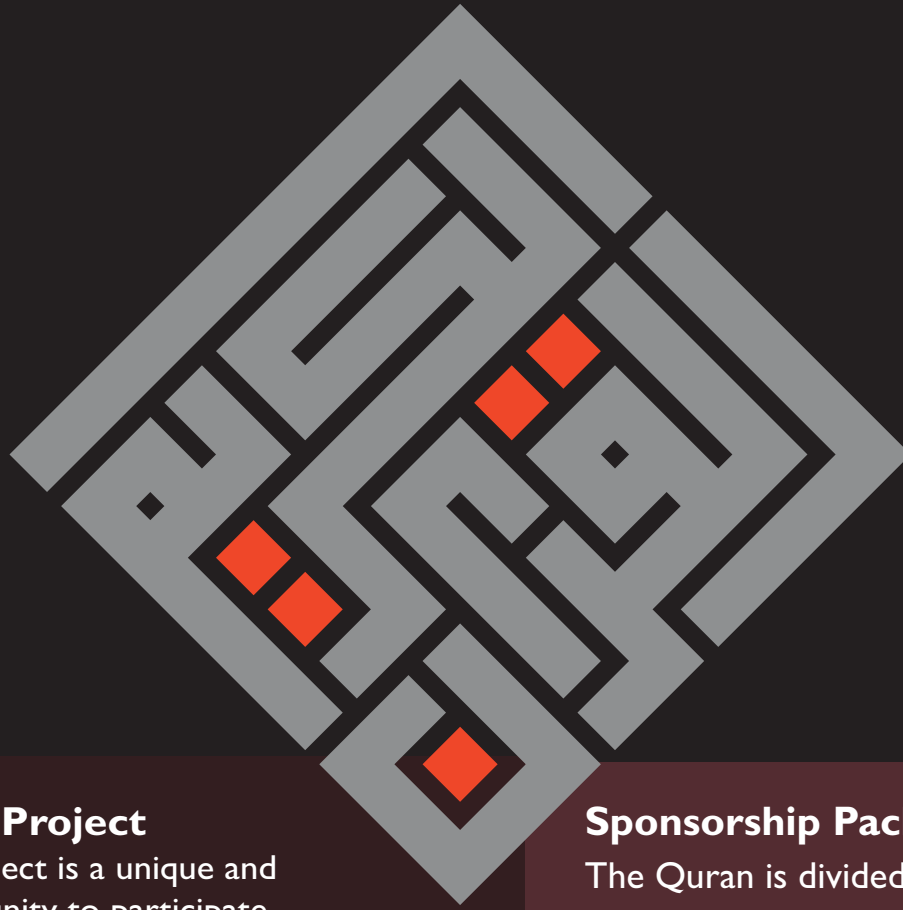

The Qur'an Project

The Qur'an Project is a unique and historic opportunity to participate in the scribing of the first Qur'an hand-written in the UK, written by world class winner of Calligraphy Sabah Arbili. This is your chance to be involved, sponsor and support the world's first handwritten Qur'an in Britain. Share with us a life long history of the making and process. The Qur'an will be made from handmade paper, handmade ink, written in Naskh style, illuminated and hand bound. This will be a one off original Qur'an in the West made for the UK. The Hand-written Qur'an will be shared between Galleries, Institutes and Museums across the UK. Sponsors will receive limited printed copies.

Our Aims:

- To produce the first handwritten Qur'an in the UK over a period of 24 months
- To travel to various Museums and Galleries throughout the UK
- To have the Qur'an and its making filmed and documented
- To deliver Calligraphy workshops
- To display the Qur'an Project across the nation
- To screen the project on a British TV channel

Sponsorship Packages

The Quran is divided into 30 chapters. In order to make the Qur'an Project a reality we are seeking one sponsor for each chapter except the 30th Chapter, which will be funded by Creative Colours. 11 UK organisations already pledged their support for the project before it was officially launched.

If interest is high, the Qur'an Project Sponsorship Panel will decide the sponsorship criteria and make the final decision on which sponsors can fund a Surah. A Sponsor can choose to sponsor more than one chapter if they wish.

One Sponsor will be selected to fund the entire project if the donation is of sufficient value.

All monies raised will pay for the delivery of the project and for the Qur'an to tour the UK and internationally during and after the lifetime of the project.
